Annual Dialysis Conference - History

- National CAPD Registry was launched in 1980, directed by Dr. Karl Nolph (University of Missouri), Dr. Jack Moncrief (Austin Diagnostic Clinic) and Dr. Robert Popovich (University of Texas)
- Dr. Nolph launched the first National CAPD conference in Kansas City in 1981, to share state-of-the-art information with centers and clinicians with CAPD activity or interest

- This evolved into the International Peritoneal Dialysis Conference, and now the Annual Dialysis Conference, presented by the Karl Nolph, MD, Division of Nephrology at University of Missouri
